**The following changes are hereby incorporated into the solicitation.**

- 1. Section L.2 is hereby amended to extend the deadline for inquiries to April 9, 2026, 2:00PM EST.**
  
2. Section B.5.4.4(c) is deleted in its entirety and replaced as follows:
  - (c) Scope: The performance adjustments apply to Medica Buys for linear TV, cable, over-the-top (OTT)/online video (OLV), connected tv (CTV), radio, and digital audio.

### **The following are responses to inquiries received.**

Question 1. I'm a CBE. I need to bring on a sub who is not a CBE to do some of the work required under the contract. I'm planning to not need them for the life of the contract. Do I still need to submit a subcontracting plan with my proposal?

Response 1. Yes. Section H.3.2 applies to CBEs, thus the CBE prime would need to subcontract 35% of the subcontracted effort to another CBE and submit an Attachment J.5 - Subcontracting Plan Form with its proposal. The District will reject any proposal that fails to include a subcontracting plan that is required by law, pursuant to Section H.3. Please refer to the FAQ #3 on the Attachment J.5 - Subcontracting Plan Form.

Question 2. My certification has lapsed, but I've reapplied with DSLBD and the status of my application is Under Review, but no ETA for approval. Can I still submit a proposal?

Response 2. In accordance with Section B.3, Offerors must be certified at the time of submittal. A proposal from an Offeror who is not certified at the time they submit their proposal will be deemed non-responsive. The OCFO will validate vendor certification with the DC Department of Small and Local Business Development (DSLBD). Offerors should contact DSLBD at (202) 727-3900 for information on the certification process.
