

1. Section C.4.1.0 is deleted in its entirety and replaced as follows:

Section C.4.1.0 The Contractor shall institute hiring and screening practices for all CSRs. The Contractor shall obtain a criminal history check as required by IRS Pub. 1075, Background Investigation Minimum Requirements from an appropriate law enforcement agency. A background investigation shall be conducted for any individual granted access to Federal Tax Information (FTI) and must include FBI fingerprinting (FD-258) which allows the agency to check the applicant's criminal history in all 50 states. The Contractor shall ensure that all investigations are completed. The OCFO will further conduct its own background investigation on all Contractor personnel. Any person employed by the Contactor shall, at the written request of the District, and within the District's sole discretion, be removed immediately by the Contractor from work related to the Contract, in accordance with Section H.1.
