

Attachment A

The following are responses to inquiries received.

Question 1. Will the District consider exceptions with regards to RFP CFOPD-22-R-024 for the contract to contain mutually acceptable language, including, but not limited to a reasonable limit on liability, termination, insurance, and indemnification obligations?

Response 1. Pursuant to Section M.1.4 of the solicitation, the Contracting Officer may elect to negotiate the contract to contain mutually acceptable language on reasonable limit on liability, termination, insurance, and indemnification obligations, where allowable under DC laws and regulations and in the District's best interest, except for: (1) to remove Section I.10, Termination for Convenience in its entirety, as the provision is governed by Title 27 of the D.C. Municipal Regulations (27 DCMR) Chapter 37, and (2) to remove Section I.14 Service Contract Act of 1965 in its entirety, as the provision is governed by 27 DCMR Section 1900.5 to be incorporated in accordance with federal regulations into all solicitations and awards.

Question 2. From RFP page 6: As part of the overall Districtwide Cost Allocation Plan, prepare a Section II (billed central service) Plan to ensure that information required for telephone services, internal service funds (intradistrict arrangements), self-insurance funds and fringe benefit funds including retirement is collected and submitted to the federal cognizant agency consistent with required deadlines. This does not mention IT services. Are they included in the Sec II report?

Response 2. The Office of the Chief Technology Officer (OCTO) provides information technology (IT) services to District agencies and bills them for the services rendered based on the terms of an executed agreement (a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between OCTO and the buying agency). Amounts are billed and paid consistent with this intradistrict arrangement. Although the referenced section of the RFP does not specifically mention IT services, it does present language that includes intradistrict arrangements. Accordingly, IT services are to be included in the Section II (Billed Services) Plan.
