

- Pursuant to Section F.2.1 – Option to Extend the Term of the Contract, the District hereby exercises Option Year 3 for the period of October 1, 2021 through September 30, 2022. The funding for this period is not to exceed \$187,920.00. The cumulative value of the contract is increased by \$187,920.00 to an amount not to exceed \$750,898.11.
