STATEMENT OF WORK

I. PROJECT OVERVIEW

Pursuant to the DC EBT Contract# CFOPD-20-C-014 (the Contract), between the District of Columbia's, Department of Human Services and FIS Information Services, LLC (the Contractor), the parties will amend the Contract to include the Summer EBT Program, authorizing the Contractor to:

a. To implement the new food benefit program, similar to SNAP – Summer EBT, for the 2023/2024 school year, as part of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2023 (PL 117-328), establishing the permanent Summer EBT program beginning in summer 2024. The Summer EBT program is intended to provide food benefits for school age children in the federal free and reduced-price meal program.

II. DELIVERABLES

The Contractor will:

- a. Create a new benefit type Summer EBT 'SEBT' for this program.
 - 1. will spend like Food benefit;
 - 2. will settle like the Cash benefit (funds will be transmitted by wire next day to settle SEBT transaction); and
- b. Expire SEBT benefits after four (4) months, from the date of issuance/availability. Once expired, SEBT benefits will be unavailable to the cardholder (date of availability plus 122 days).
- c. Setup the Benefit Expiration process to remove SEBT benefit type from the database 62 days after the expiration date, if there are any remaining benefits on the authorization file.
- d. Provide one Ad Hoc report per month listing all SEBT benefits, the remaining amount if any and the expiration date.
- e. Provide monthly report (EBTMS516) to include the SEBT benefit type itemized and available on the Reports Portal.
- f. Notify FIS Call Center of the SEBT 2024 program changes.
- g. Create a separate card production stream to produce the Capital Access EBT card for cases receiving only SEBT benefits.
 - 1. Print "SUN Bucks" in the upper corner of the card for SEBT only cases.
 - 2. Modify the card carrier based on input from the District to mail with the SEBT only card
- h. Work with the District to order cardstock as needed.
- i. Perform internal Quality Control testing.
- j. Update the District's EBT manuals (Detail Design and Appendix S).

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k. Notify FIS Card Distribution facilities/associates, located on 1649 Good Hope Rd SE and H Street NE, of the Summer EBT program changes.

III. CONTIGENCIES

- 1. Contractor Performance under this modification is contingent upon:
 - a. District understanding and agreement that anything not outlined in the modification is outside of the scope of this project.

2. The District's understanding that:

- a. SEBT benefits will be comingled with existing food benefits.
- b. District will use the new "SEBT" benefit type configured on the Contractor's system.
- c. No new interface will be defined.
- d. There will be no new changes to existing file and report layout.
- e. There will be no new changes to card design and materials aside from printing SUN Bucks on card and updating the card carrier for the SEBT only cases.
- b. No custom reporting and no changes to IVR messages.
- c. The SEBT benefit will not post to AMA, but rather settle like Cash benefits.
- d. The District will Fedwire the Contractor the funds each day, as with Cash benefits settlement.
- e. There will be no new batch streams or web service messages defined.
- f. It will take up to six weeks from the modification execution date to ramp up the Call Center support team.
- g. SEBT benefits will:
 - i. Be used for SEBT program only.
 - ii. Be configured in the FIS system as a Food benefit, but it will settle as cash.
 - iii. Show on existing reports the same as the other SNAP benefit(s), however on the settlement reports, the benefit will show in a separate Group under Cash benefits.
 - iv. Be comingled with existing food benefits.
- h. New cards for new cases will be produced following the District's existing card issuance process with no PIN.
- i. In cases where there is no social security number for the account, activation instructions will advise the cardholder to use their zip code instead.
- i. All Summer EBT only cases will be sent with a custom card carrier.
- k. Over the counter cards for Summer EBT only will not contain "SUN Bucks" on the front of the card.
- l. If there's a large bulk order of cards 5,000 (five thousand) or more, the card production will be scheduled over multiple days/weeks, based on the Contractor card production availability and the volume of cards ordered.
- m. The benefit file must be sent the same day as the case setup for Summer EBT cases to receive "SUN Bucks" printed on the mailed card.
- n. Pricing provided in the modification for 2024 Summer EBT only.
- o. For Summer EBT benefits only cases will be charged a one-time fee for the first month, but no additional fee will be charged for following Summer EBT month benefits.
- p. The fee remains the same whether the District issues one lump sum Summer benefit or issues monthly benefits (1-3 months) for the summer months.
- q. If the case is Summer EBT only, no additional CPCM will be charged for the case in the following months for the summer period.

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3. DISTRICT OBLIGATIONS:

- a. Allow Summer EBT only cards to be produced at any of FIS card distribution facilities and or associates if needed to fulfill the orders.
- b. Use existing District methods to establish and maintain cases.
- c. Use existing District methods to apply benefits.
- d. Issue the first benefit on the same day the initial card is requested.
- e. Provide to the Contractor no later than April 15, 2024:
 - i. Projected number of SEBT cases,
 - ii. Custom card carrier verbiage in English and Spanish using existing card carrier specification, and
 - iii. Review custom card carrier proof and provide final approval to the Contractor no later than April 15, 2024.
- f. Inform and educate cardholders regarding the Summer EBT 2024 program, such as period of benefit availability (4 months, use them or lose them), how to set a PIN for new cases, address updates, etc.
- g. Ensure their Management Information System (MIS) can:
 - i. Issue SEBT benefits using standard daily/monthly demographic and benefit file layouts and transfer protocols.
 - ii. Receive Activity and Aging files from FIS that contain SEBT benefits related records.
- h. Share cardholder communication for Summer EBT 2024 with the Contractor.
- i. Share FNS approved Summer EBT 2024 plan with the Contractor once approved.

V. PAYMENT TERMS:

This modification is payable as follows.

- a. Payment terms points
 - 1. 100% of the implementation cost of \$23,000 to be invoiced and due with the District of Columbia following the execution of the contract modification.
 - 2. 100% of the Processing Fee of \$6.00 to be invoiced and due to the District of Columbia following the receipt of Summer EBT benefit when the associated case has not already been billed. The processing months are June Sept of the Option Period.

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- b. No government funds to be paid under this modification are being or will be used to develop any current or future intellectual property of the Contractor except as expressly established in this modification. No rights in intellectual property will be transferred pursuant to this modification.
- c. This modification supersedes any verbal agreements or understandings made previously regarding this subject.
