

The following are responses to inquiries received.

Question 1. Per Response #6, are we correct in stating that the total number of individuals screened on behalf of the Office in 2020 was 329? If this assumption is correct, can the Office confirm that future volume is anticipated to be 500 applicants screened annually or less? We would like to ascertain the estimated number of applicants screened annually as it will drive pricing and in turn, how we fulfill requirements pertaining to subcontracting and the DC resident clause.

Response 6 It is a safe assumption to believe that OIO will not exceed 500 background investigations in the near future. However, OIO did complete 617 background investigations in 2017. Currently, the OCFO does not have the same level of staffing to complete a similar volume.
