C.4.41.1 Position Description: The contractor personnel shall perform the following duties and responsibilities:

- a. Automating Cloud Tasks and strong knowledge of VCN
- b. Use the OCI CLI to simplify repetitive tasks, utilize configuration management tools to control infrastructure, Manage infrastructure as code
- c. Performance Tuning and Troubleshooting, Validating OCI performance
- d. Utilize billing tools to track cost, Implement compartment quotas, budgets and billing alerts
- e. Security and Compliance.
- f. Create secure access control policies, Configure Vulnerability Scanning and Web Application Firewall, Describe and Configure OCI Vault

- g. Understand Metric Query Language (MQL), Create and managing alarms, Implement automated notifications
- h. Use Object Storage Lifecycle policies for tiered data storage, manage automated block storage and database backups, Implement cross-region data copy strategies
- i. Analyze, debug, and interact with Oracle Support to resolve issues related to Oracle Cloud
- j. Utilize edge services for automated failover/recovery, Implement hybrid network environments
- k. Assess the impact of potential changes and implement solutions to mitigate negative outcomes.
- l. Work with Oracle Support on any issues encountered
- m. Support troubleshooting of any issues in the environments
- n. Monitor Performance and Space and perform Capacity Planning

- e. Excellent analysis skills and the ability to develop processes and methodologies.
- f. Demonstrated management, analytical, organization, interpersonal, and communication skills, and highly developed Microsoft Suite skills (Word, Excel) required.
