### 1. AUTHORIZATION:

# 2. MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

The Office of the Chief Financial Officer ("OCFO") for the District of Columbia ("District") and the Office of Contracts on behalf of the Office of Lottery and Gaming has a minimum need for Sports Wagering, Lottery Gaming Systems and Related services for the District.

# 3. <u>ESTIMATED REASONABLE PRICE AND REASONABLENESS</u> <u>DETERMINATION:</u>

The estimated not to exceed contract total price is \$215,000,000.
