ATTACHMENT A

MODIFICATION NO. 5 OF CONTRACT NO. CFOPD-19-C-041 SPORTS BETTING, LOTTERY GAMING SYSTEMS AND RELATED SERVICES

Contract NO. CFOPD-19-C-041, Sports Betting, Lottery Gaming Systems and Related Services (Contract) is modified as follows:

I. Numbered Paragraph 2 of Section B.4.8 (Sports Betting) is amended to read as follows:

2. (a) The Contractor shall seek approval from the OLG on an annual basis (1 year in advance) the payout of the sportsbook product to be offered both in retail and online channels and agrees that the reconciliation of the payout will be on biennial basis. The Contractor shall guarantee the payout as a percentage (%) of handle (defined to mean the amount wagered by bettors) and any differences in the reconciliation will be credited to OLG from the Contractor on a biennial basis. For the first year, the sportsbook payout shall not exceed eighty percent (80%) of handle and Contractor shall be responsible for all payouts above the eighty percent (80%) limit.

(b) 90% Payout Pilot Program.

- Notwithstanding the foregoing, and unless terminated sooner by the OLG, a pilot program shall be conducted between the date this Modification is executed by the Contracting Officer for the Office of the Chief Financial (Effective Date of Modification 5), and January 31, 2023, whereby the payout limit referenced in numbered Paragraph 2 (a) of Section B.4.8 is increased to 90% of handle ("90% Payout Pilot Program").
- (ii) At its option, the OLG may terminate the 90% Payout Pilot Program at any time prior to January 31, 2023.
- (iii) Prior to the termination date of the initial Payout Pilot Program (the "Initial Pilot Program), the OLG may send written notice to the Contractor directing continuation of the 90% Payout Pilot Program beyond January 31, 2023, until a new payout limit is established in accordance with numbered Paragraph 1 of Section B.4.8 of the Contract.
- (iv) The payout limit between May 28, 2020 (the date of first sportsbook sales) and the Effective Date of Modification 5 shall remain 80% of handle. However, reconciliation of the of the initial payout limit period (May 28, 2020 through the Effective Date of Modification 5) shall not occur until after the 90% Payout Pilot Program or any continuation thereof has ended. Thereafter, Contractor shall be provided with an additional three (3)

months from the end of the 90% Payout Pilot Program.to comply with the initial 80% of handle payout limit.

(v) Upon termination of the Initial Pilot Program, either on January 31, 2023, or upon an earlier date as directed by the OLG, the payout limit shall revert back to 80% of handle.

II. Numbered Paragraph 6 of Section B.4.8 (Sports Betting) is amended to read as follows:

6. The OLG agrees to pay the Contractor 42.5% of sports betting GGR for the duration of the Contract base period and for the extensions of the Contract for the platform, risk and trading and marketing related managed services. GGR is gross sports wagering sales minus the winner payout, e.g. all money paid to winners but, excluding any guaranteed payouts and special jackpot contributions that are not mutually agreed by the Parties. For the term of the Initial 90% Pilot Program, when calculating payments due to Contractor, GGR shall not include promotional or bonus wagers.

III. Except as expressly amended or modified hereby, all terms, conditions and provisions of the Contract are and shall remain in full force and effect and all references therein to such Contract shall henceforth refer to the Contract as modified by this Amendment. This Amendment shall be deemed incorporated into, and made a part of, the Contract.
