1. <u>AUTHORIZATION:</u>

The Office of the Chief Financial Officer, Office of Tax and Revenue has a need for the production and printing of the Government's Tax Forms and related items, to include folding and stuffing envelopes and all services necessary for the mailing of notices and forms to taxpayers. Print-on-Demand services are required.

3. <u>ESTIMATED REASONABLE PRICE AND REASONABLENESS</u> <u>DETERMINATION:</u>

The estimated contract total price is \$747,203.00.

Contract Specialist Reasonableness Determination:

- (a) The cost of this contract is of a type generally recognized as ordinary and necessary for the conduct of the contractor or the performance of the contract.
