#### 1. INTRODUCTION

The District of Columbia Office of the Chief Financial Officer (OCFO), Office of the Chief Information Officer (OCIO) is awarding a contract to provide Termed licenses for Tableau Software server and desktop. - a) Delivery or performance shall be made only as authorized by orders issued in accordance with any purchase order issued against the contract. The District will order at least the minimum quantity specified in the Schedule.
