- Item 2: The total cumulative contract value, up to and including exercised Option Year Three is hereby increased from \$19,766,922.29 by \$396,776.00 to an amount Not to Exceed \$20,163,698.29.
- Item 3: Section C.4 Definitions is hereby revised to add the following terms associated with the CLINs for third-party skip tracing services:
  - C.4.13Inventory Skip All existing inventory is forwarded out for social security number (SSN) skip tracing.
  - C.4.14 Forward Flow Skip Any new account received after initial Inventory Skip (listed above) sent out for SSN skip tracing.
  - C.4.15 Upfront Programming and Meeting Programming needed to send files to Skip Tracing Vendors, send updated data to DC CCU and any other set-up needed to run the program. Meetings are the implementation calls centered around the set-up of the Clean Hands Skip Tracing project inclusive of the SSN Skip Tracing process.
  - C.4.16 On-Going Programming and Meeting This would be applicable when implementing a new agency for the CCU and therefore having to update the existing Clean Hands Program to include the new agency(s).
  - C.4.17 Administrative (A&F/invoicing) Cost associated with accounting and finance functions for monthly tracking and invoicing for the Skip Tracing project.

Item 5: Section C.9.3 is deleted in its entirety and replaced as follows to incorporate skip tracing services.

C.9.3 Skip Tracing Services

1. The Contractor shall scrub data files from agencies and update them with social security numbers (SSN) and/or Employer Identification Numbers (EIN) using two outsourced Skip Tracing Vendors (Primary and Secondary) with return results from both within 10-14 days. The Contractor shall pass this improved data file to the District for the specific use for payment, to identify accounts without Clean Hands. The Contractor will not receive collection fees on recalled accounts or offset payments.

2. The Skip Tracing project design and timeline shall be provided. The implementation of the Clean Hands Skip Tracing project shall be tracked through Monday.com and OFT shall be invited to the Board to review the Contractor's progress. The Contractor shall complete the file layout and setup to send data for SSN scrubs to both vendors.

3. The project will entail scheduled meetings for the initial programming and verification with OTR of the following items:

- a) File layout with Scrub Results
- b) Checklist of programming items are completed
- c) Progress of upfront programming
- d) File Testing

- e) Invoice Specifications
- f) Automation of tasks
- 4. Once programming and testing have been completed, the Contractor shall provide regularly scheduled files of the scrub results for OTR to upload. The Contractor shall continue to work the accounts in the CCU system and receive collection fees on any payment received. The Contractor will not receive collection fees on recalled accounts or offset payments.
- 5. The Contractor shall incur the costs from its Skip Tracing Vendors, include the costs of programming, maintenance and any administrative costs.
- 6. The Skip Tracing process shall be as follows:
  - a) The Contractor shall complete a comparison to internal data. The frequency will be monthly.
  - b) The inventory shall be sent to the Primary Vendor monthly by the 10th calendar day.
  - c) Any inventory remaining that did not receive a match from the Primary Vendor will be sent monthly to the Secondary Vendor by the 17th calendar day.
  - d) A file of all qualified and updated accounts will be forwarded to OTR by the 25th calendar day of each month.
  - e) The invoicing for the results will be include in the Contractor's invoice generated the following month.
