1. AUTHORIZATION:

D.C. Mun. Regs. tit. 27 §§1206.6, 1540.1, 1625, 1626, and 3307

2. MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

The District of Columbia has a requirement for a Contractor to provide Data Warehouse Maintenance services.

3. COST AND REASONABLENESS DETERMINATION:

Estimated Reasonable cost: \$249,163.33.

Contract Specialist Reasonableness Determination:

- (a) The cost of this contract is of a type generally recognized as ordinary and necessary for the conduct of the contractor or the performance of the contract.
- (b) This contract includes the restraints or requirements imposed by generally accepted sound business practices, arms length bargaining, federal and District laws and regulations, and contract terms and specifications.
- (c) This action is an action that a prudent businessperson would take, considering responsibilities to the owner of the business, employees, customers, the District, and the public at large.
- (d) There are no significant deviations from the established practices of the contractor that may unjustifiably increase the contract costs.
- (e) There are no other relevant factors that should be noted at this time.

4. **JUSTIFICATION OF REASONABLENESS OF PRICE:**

The price received to provide Data Warehouse Maintenance from GovOS is competitive with the market for similar services.


5. **PRICING**

In accordance with D.C. Mun. Regs. tit. 27 §§1625 and 1626 the Contracting Officer has determined that based on the independent District cost estimates that GovOS provided a reasonable price to the District.

On the basis of the foregoing assessments and evaluation, the Contracting Officer finds the pricing to be fair and reasonable and recommends GovOS for the award.
