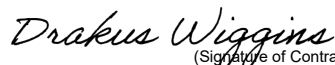

APPENDIX A

ACACIA'S DISCLOSURES PURSUANT TO MSRB RULE G-42 AND G-10

1. DOCUMENTATION OF MUNICIPAL ADVISORY RELATIONSHIP: The contract to which this Appendix A is attached, includes a description of (i) scope of services to be provided as described in Section C – Scope of Service; (ii) the form of compensation payable to Acacia for municipal advisory services as described in Section B – Compensation and in Section F – Referenced documents; (iii) and termination provisions as described in Section I – Termination of Agreement.
2. CONFLICTS OF INTEREST. Acacia receives compensation for municipal advisory activities to be performed that (i) is contingent upon the size of the transaction, which could create an incentive to otherwise increase the size of a transaction; or (ii) is contingent upon the closing of the transaction, which could create an incentive to otherwise close a transaction. Acacia manages this conflict by implementing written policies and procedures for supervision that ensure that Acacia adheres to its fiduciary duties to its municipal advisory clients. Acacia is not aware, after reasonable inquiry, of any other actual or potential material conflict of interest that could reasonably be anticipated to impair its ability to provide advice to or on behalf of its clients in accordance with its fiduciary duties to its clients.
3. LEGAL OR DISCIPLINARY EVENTS. Acacia does not have any legal or disciplinary events that are material to a client's evaluation of Acacia or the integrity of Acacia's management or advisory personnel.
