**1. AUTHORIZATION:**

D.C. Mun. Regs. tit. 27 §1540.1, 1625, 1626, and 3307; PPRA §419

**2. MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:**

The District of Columbia has a requirement for a Contractor to provide Lottery Draw Services for the DC Lottery Board and Charitable Games (DCLB).

**3. COST AND REASONABLENESS DETERMINATION:**

Estimated Reasonable cost: \$244,776.00.

Contract Specialist Reasonableness Determination:

- (a) The cost of this contract is of a type generally recognized as ordinary and necessary for the conduct of the contractor or the performance of the contract.
- (b) This contract includes the restraints or requirements imposed by generally accepted sound business practices, arms length bargaining, federal and District laws and regulations, and contract terms and specifications.
- (c) This action is an action that a prudent business person would take, considering responsibilities to the owner of the business, employees, customers, the District, and the public at large.
- (d) There are no significant deviations from the established practices of the contractor that may unjustifiably increase the contract costs.
- (e) There are no other relevant factors that should be noted at this time.

4. **JUSTIFICATION OF REASONABLENESS OF PRICE:**

The Contracting Officer has performed a cost analysis to determine the reasonableness of the price and the Contracting Officer has found that the price is fair and reasonable. The price received in response to Request for Proposal (RFP) CFOPD-11-R-042 from Scientific Games International Inc. is competitive with the prices that other offeror(s) submitted in response to the RFP. All potential option periods were competed and found reasonable at contract award. Thus, Scientific Games International Inc. presents the best value to the District based on their proposal submitted.

5. **PRICING**

In accordance with D.C. Mun. Regs. tit. 27 §§1625 and 1626; PPRA §419 the Contracting Officer has determined that based on the independent District cost estimates and comparison of the prices received in response to the solicitation that Scientific Games International Inc. provides the best value to the District.

On the basis of the foregoing assessments and evaluation, the Contracting Officer finds the pricing to be fair and reasonable and recommends Scientific Games International Inc. for award on the basis of lowest price and ability to meet the requirements of the solicitation.
