**FINDINGS**

**1. AUTHORIZATION:**

D.C. Municipal Regulations Title 27 §3307 and PPRA §419

**2. MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:**

The District of Columbia Office of the Chief Financial Officer (OCFO), Office of Management and Administration, Office of Logistics and Support Services (Logistics) has a need for lease and maintenance of Phase 2 copier machines for OCFO program offices.

**3. ESTIMATED REASONABLE PRICE AND REASONABLENESS DETERMINATION:**

The estimated fair and reasonable price is \$15,391.00 based on historical data of the previous copiers.

Contracting Officer Reasonableness Determination:

- (a) The cost of this contract is of a type generally recognized as ordinary and necessary for the conduct of the contractor or the performance of the contract.
- (b) This contract includes the restraints or requirements imposed by generally accepted sound business practices, arms length bargaining, federal and District laws and regulations, and contract terms and specifications.
- (c) This action is an action that a prudent business person would take, considering responsibilities to the owner of the business, employees, customers, the District, and the public at large.
- (d) There are no significant deviations from the established practices of the contractor that may unjustifiably increase the contract costs.
- (e) There are no other relevant factors that should be noted at this time.

- (f) A review of wage rates for specialized consultants with over 20 years of experience in the area and for these services indicates that the costs associated with this contract is commensurate with the general market.
- (g) The pricing contained in this contract is equivalent to the contractor's pricing as reflected in the contractor's cooperative agreement contract.

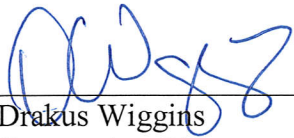
4. **JUSTIFICATION OF REASONABLENESS OF PRICE:**

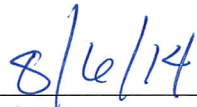
The Contracting Officer has performed a cost analysis to determine the reasonableness of the price and the Contracting Officer has found that the price is fair and reasonable.

5. **CERTIFICATION BY CONTRACTING OFFICERS**

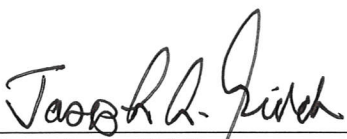
